The literal and symbolic significance has profound meaning as a verb—the act of emergence from silence imposed by the pandemic and celebration of the voices that are emerging. So when the MFA Design Class of 2021 proposed "Unmute" as their venture theme and subtitle, the response was resoundingly positive—it is a readymade description for the release of our 2021's entrepreneurial bounty.

There can be no argument that this past year has been transformative. Everyone was driven to embrace novel methods of learning, teaching and sharing. Communication systems that barely existed months before the pandemic arrived-Canvas and Miro-came to the fore as sharing tools that had to be learned from scratch. Rather than being stranded, however, Zoom was the lifesaver-like electric generators that automatically restore power in a storm. This technology enabled classes to proceed remotely, in fact, sometimes better than during normalcy. MFA Design students and faculty rose to the occasion too, with barely a hiccup. Venture 21 Unmute is the proud outcome of two intersecting forces: a solid foundation of teaching and learning facilitated by extraordinary instructors and advisors; and a class of gifted and dedicated MFA students who agreed not to allow any obstacle obstruct their goal-that is, to create viable and sustainable ventures that will make a difference to their respective audiences.

We applaud their efforts and gratefully celebrate their fortitude and discipline necessary to conceive, prototype and fabricate their individual ventures. Each one splendidly accomplished in this inspiring time.

Other ventures compel us to reconsider our views and way of living in the 21st century — **Tiffany Pai's** magazine Lotus encourages Asian Americans to engage politically. EqualTwo is a sustainable streetwear brand by **Sukanya Bose** that compels us to rethink waste and what we find valuable. Fay Qiu's venture, Tang Ren, aims to encourage young New Yorkers to find a sense of kinship with Chinatown and hence reinvigorate the neighborhood. Children of Earth by Rohan Rege provides a platform for upcoming musicians from around the world through a curated playlist that celebrates cultural diversity.

And some ventures have innovated through design a new way of experiencing systems. Bringing with them fresh energy of change. Bill Chien's mobile companion Newbie provides guidance to incoming international students; Neulu, an analog kit designed by Eunji Kim, helps the elderly understand smartphones better and battle their fear of advanced technology. Ashlyn Stewart Cavitt's app School me brims with promise as it introduces financial literacy to college and high school students. Unfork the Earth, a product by Michael Kao, campaigns

to stop the use of plastic cutlery and suggests a new way around!

Engaging audiences to enjoy the process of creativity is an integral part of Catreen Yoon's venture, Axial, helping children learn 3D modeling in a fun way. Renee Freiha turns cooking from a chore to a delight with her app Itch in the Kitchen. **Tracy Huang**'s Paper Airplane encourages people to start writing postcards again, and Soyum by **Ruolin Feng** is a platform that brings healthy home-cooked Chinese food to every kitchen through sessions with contemporary chefs!
